ADDITIONAL PARTICULAR AVERAGE CLAUSES (B-2) 01/04/90 (Japan)

Article 1.

This insurance shall be extended to cover Particular Average in respect of damage to the Vessel caused by the following :-

(a) Explosions (on shipboard or elsewhere)

(b) Accidents in and due to loading, discharging or shifting cargo, appurtenances, or any consumable stores such as fuel or provisions.

(c) Accidents to main machinery, propeller shafts, propellers or boilers.

(d) Accidents to auxiliary machinery which is installed in machinery room, cargo pump room and/or refrigerating machinery room for reefer cargo holds.

(e) Accident to emergency generators, steering engines, refrigerating machinery for provision stores, machinery for inert gas systems, special machinery for liquefied petroleum gas, side thrusters, or fin stabilizers.

(f) Accidents caused by negligence of Master Officers Crew or Pilots.

provided that such damage has not resulted from want of due diligence by the Assured, Owners or Managers.

Masters Officers Crew or Pilots not to be considered as part Owners within the meaning of this clause should they hold shares in the Vessel.

In cases where such damage has been caused by a latent defect which could not be found in spite of due diligence exercised by the Assured, Particular Average in respect of damage to the part in which the latent defect exists shall also be indemnified hereunder.

Article 2.

No claim for Particular Average arising from any of the causes enumerated in the preceding Article 1 and recoverable hereunder only by reason of these clauses shall be payable unless the aggregate of all such claims arising out of each separate accident or occurrence exceeds the amount specified in the policy in which case this sum shall be deducted.

Article 3.

The foregoing clauses shall not apply to claims to be indemnified under any other clauses in this Policy, even if the claims are for Particulars Average in respect of damage caused by the accident enumerated in Article 1. above.
