ADDITIONAL PARTICULAR AVERAGE CLAUSES (C) 01/04/90
(Japan)

1. The Company shall indemnify the Assured for Particular Average in respect of damage to the Vessel directly caused by heavy weather.
2. No claim for Particular Average arising from the cause notified in the preceding Clause 1 and recoverable hereunder only by reasons of these clauses shall be payable unless the sum arising out of each separate accident or occurrence exceeds [the deductible] as per schedule in which case the sum shall be deducted.
3. Claims for damage by heavy weather occurring during a single sea passage between the port of departure and the subsequent port of destination shall be treated as being due to one accident.
4. In the case of such heavy weather extending over a period not wholly covered by this insurance, the claim recoverable hereunder shall be the proportion that the number of days of such heavy weather during the single sea passage.
5. The foregoing clauses shall not apply to claims to be indemnified under any other clauses in this Policy, even if the claims are for Particular Average in respect of damage caused by the accidents notified in clause 1 above.
