REPORTS ON ACTS OF PIRACY AND ARMED ROBBERY AGAINST SHIPS

Annual report - 2005

1 The Maritime Safety Committee, at its sixty-fifth session in May 1995, instructed the Secretariat to issue, as from 31 July 1995, monthly reports of all incidents of piracy and armed robbery against ships reported to the Organization and, in addition, on a quarterly basis, composite reports accompanied by an analysis, on a regional basis, of the situation and an indication whether the frequency of incidents is increasing or decreasing and advising on any new feature or pattern of significance.

2 At its sixty-sixth session in June 1996, the Committee further instructed the Secretariat to prepare, after March of every year, an annual summary of all acts of piracy and armed robbery against ships, which had occurred during the previous year and had been reported to the Organization, based on their actual date and time of occurrence.

3 Pursuant to this request, the annex hereto provides information on reports of piracy and armed robbery against ships received by the Secretariat since 1984, when relevant statistics started being compiled and, in particular, those which occurred in the course of 2005 as well as a regional analysis thereof.

4 The number of acts of piracy and armed robbery against ships, which were reported to the Organization to have occurred or to have been attempted in 2005, was 266, a decrease of 64 (19%) over the figure for 2004.

5 From the information referred to above, it emerges that the areas most affected in 2005 were the Far East, in particular the South China Sea and the Malacca Strait, West Africa, South America and the Caribbean*, the Indian Ocean and East Africa. Over the period under review, the number of acts reported to have occurred or to have been attempted decreased from 113 to 97 in the South China Sea, from 60 to 20 in the Malacca Strait, from 57 to 23 in West Africa and from 46 to 26 in South America and the Caribbean. There was an increase in the number of incidents from 13 to 49 in East Africa and from 41 to 51 in the Indian Ocean, over the 2004 figures. Most of the attacks worldwide were reported to have occurred or to have been attempted in the coastal States' concerned territorial waters while the ships were at anchor or berthed. In many of the reports received, the crews were violently attacked by groups of five to ten people carrying knives or guns.

6 From the same information, it emerges that, during the period under review, one hundred and fifty-two (152) crew members were reportedly injured/assaulted. About six hundred and fifty-two (652) crew members were reportedly taken hostage/kidnapped out of which eleven (11) crew members were reportedly still unaccounted for. Sixteen ships (16) were reportedly hijacked and a tug and barge was still unaccounted for.

* As reported to MSC 76 (MSC 76/23, paragraph 16.2), the geographically large South American and Caribbean region has been sub-divided into three regions: South America (Atlantic), South America (Pacific) and the Caribbean. This change is reflected in all relevant reports issued as of 1 January 2003.

7 The total number of incidents of piracy and armed robbery against ships, reported to have occurred or to have been attempted from 1984 to the end of December 2005, has risen to 3992.

8 With regard to acts of piracy and armed robbery against ships reported to the Organization, information on acts of piracy and armed robbery against ships reported to the Organization to have occurred or to have been attempted during 2005 has been circulated by means of monthly reports (MSC.4/Circ.65, MSC.4/Circ.66, MSC.4/Circ.67, MSC.4/Circ.68, MSC.4/Circ.70, MSC.4/Circ.71, MSC.4/Circ.73, MSC.4/Circ.74, MSC.4/Circ.75, MSC.4/Circ.77, MSC.4/Circ.78, and MSC.4/Circ.79) and quarterly reports (MSC.4/Circ.69, MSC.4/Circ.72, MSC.4/Circ.76, and MSC.4/Circ.80).

9 The annexes to this document provide a breakdown of the information referred to above as follows:

- .1 annex 1 provides a list of all acts reported to have occurred or to have been attempted in 2005 in chronological order of occurrence;
- .2 annex 2 provides a regional analysis of acts reported to have occurred or to have been attempted in 2005;
- .3 annex 3 provides a graphic presentation by location and month of occurrence of the 2005 acts reported to have occurred or to have been attempted;
- .4 annex 4 provides maps showing the location of acts reported to have occurred or to have been attempted during 2005; and
- .5 annex 5 provides a graphic presentation, on an annual basis, of reports received between 1984 and February 2006 based on their time of occurrence.

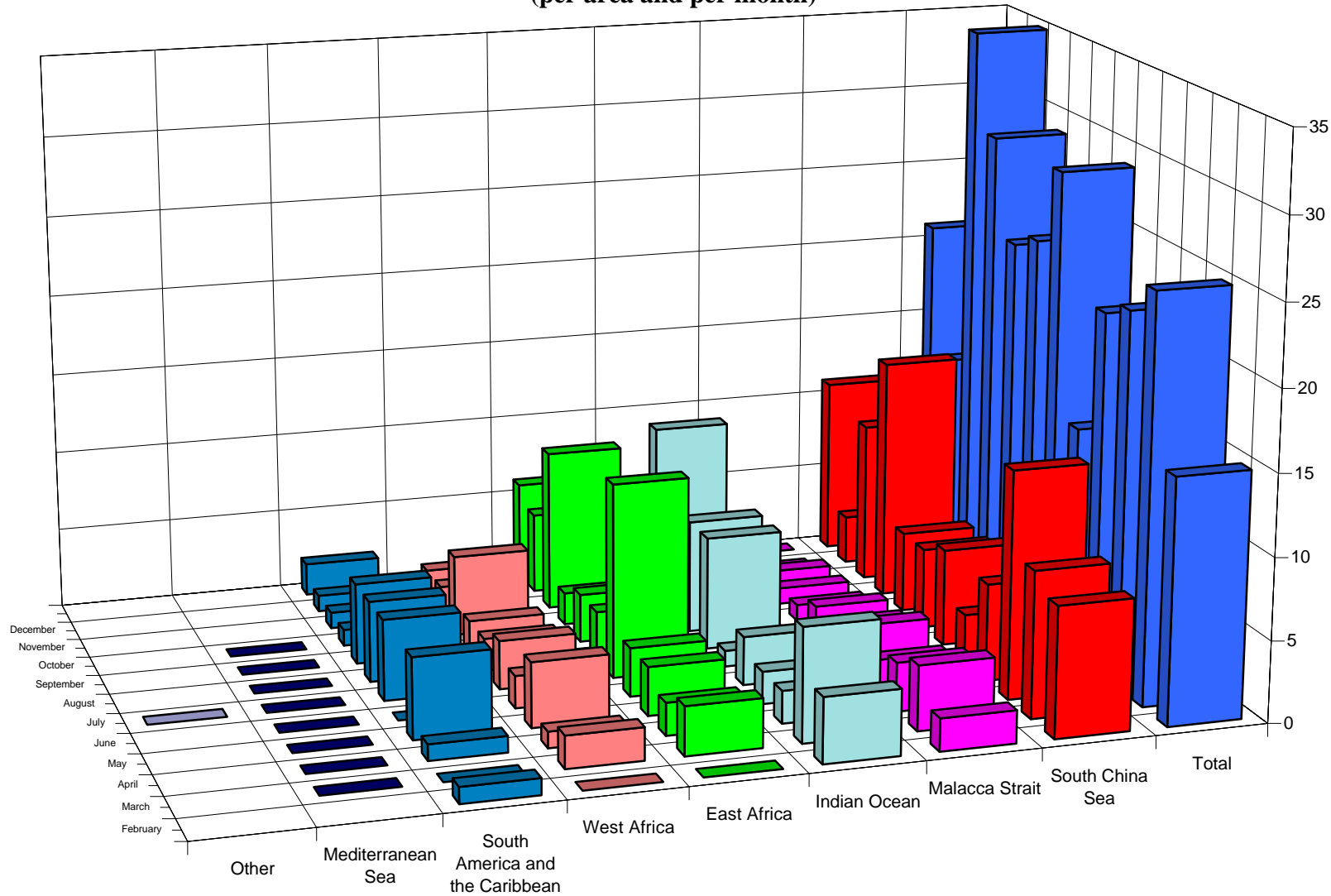

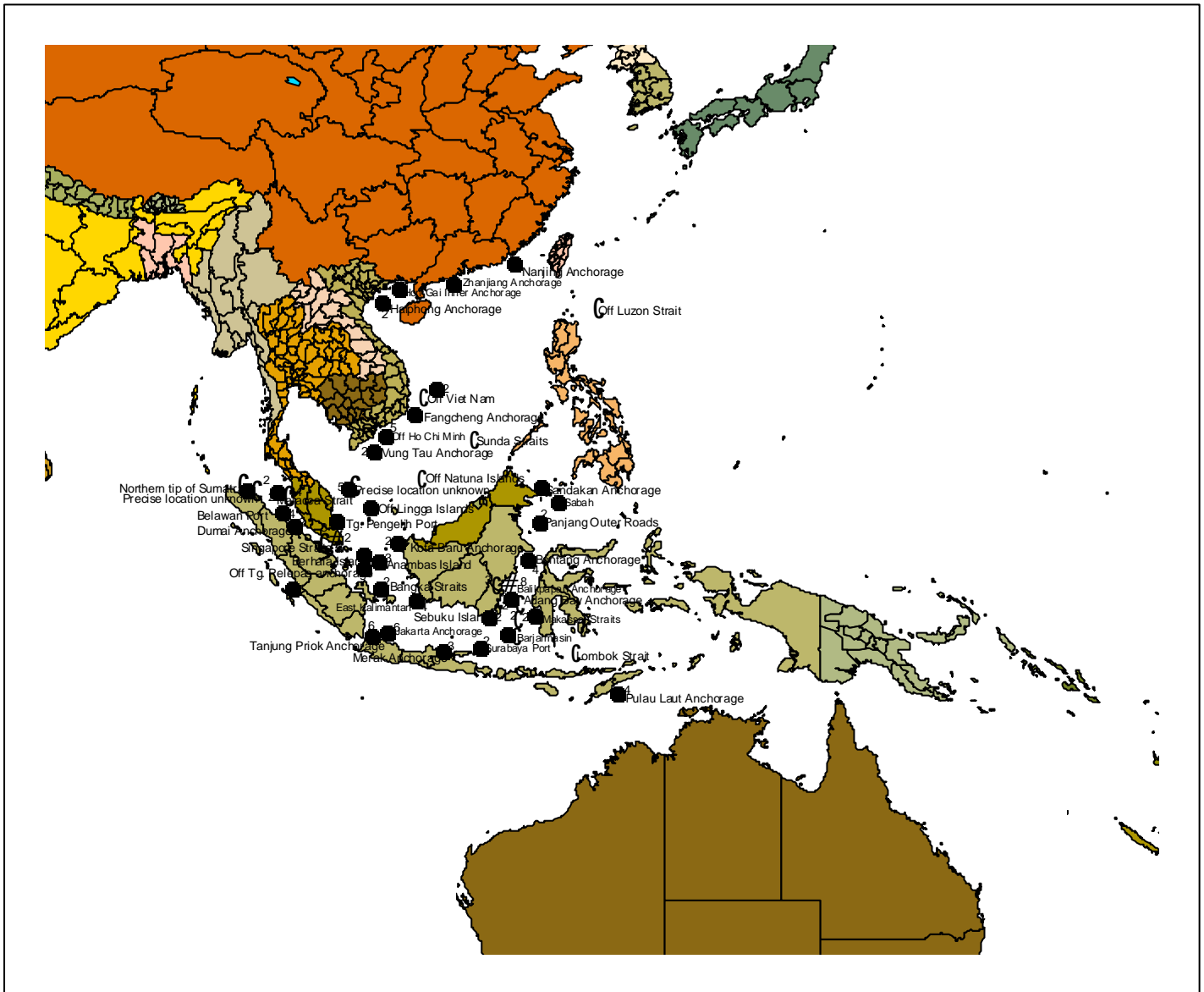

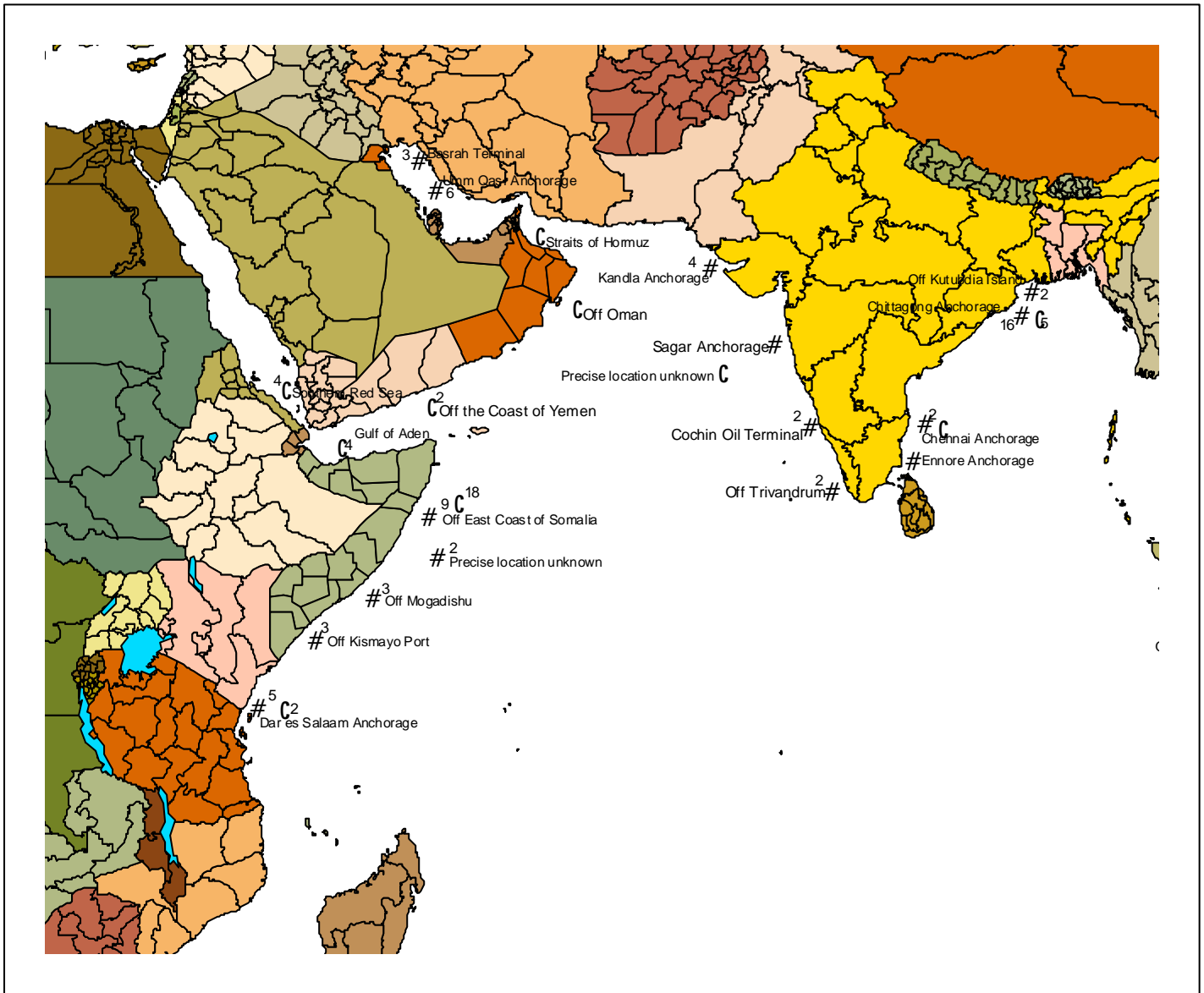
SOUTH CHINA SEA AND MALACCA STRAIT

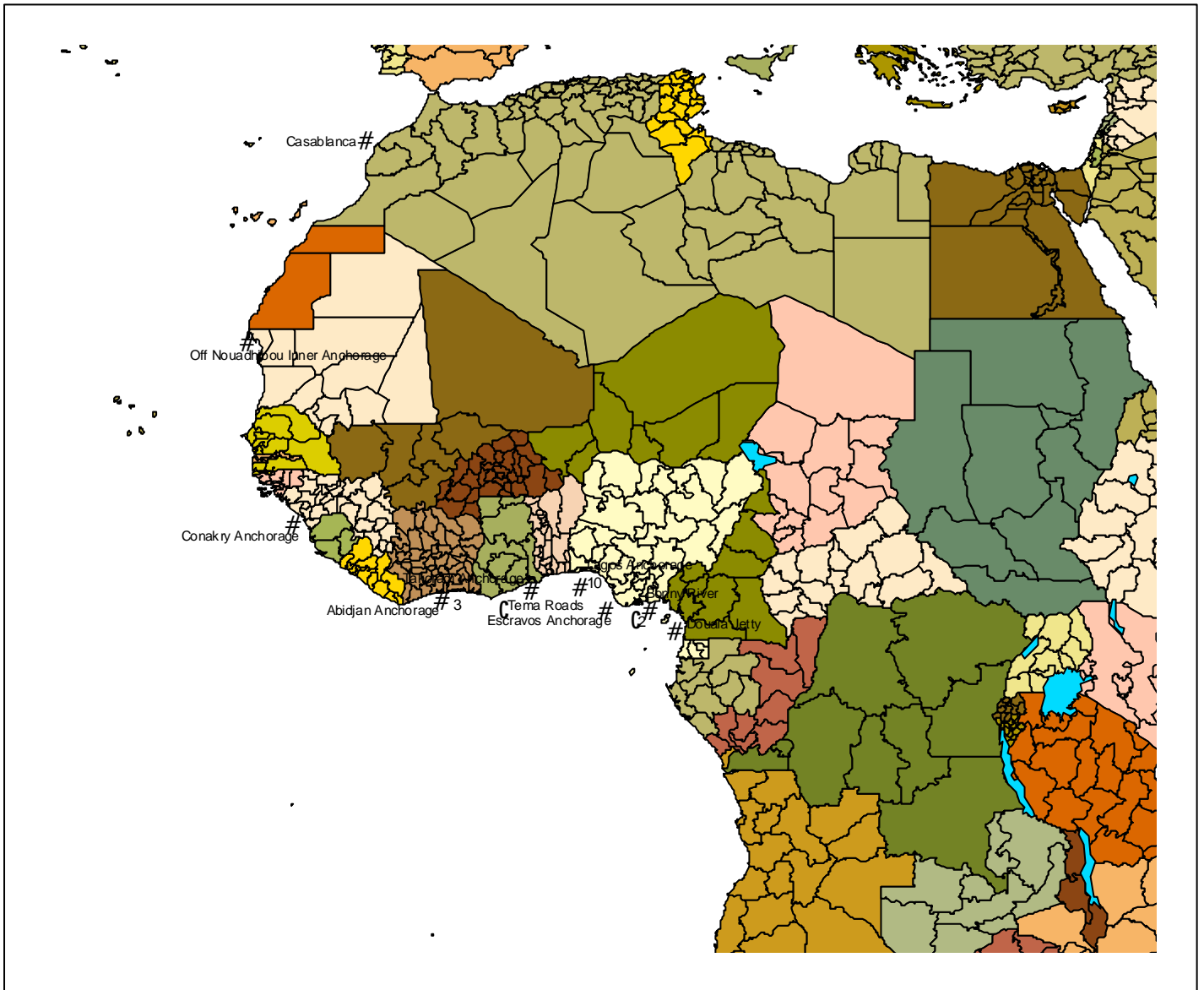

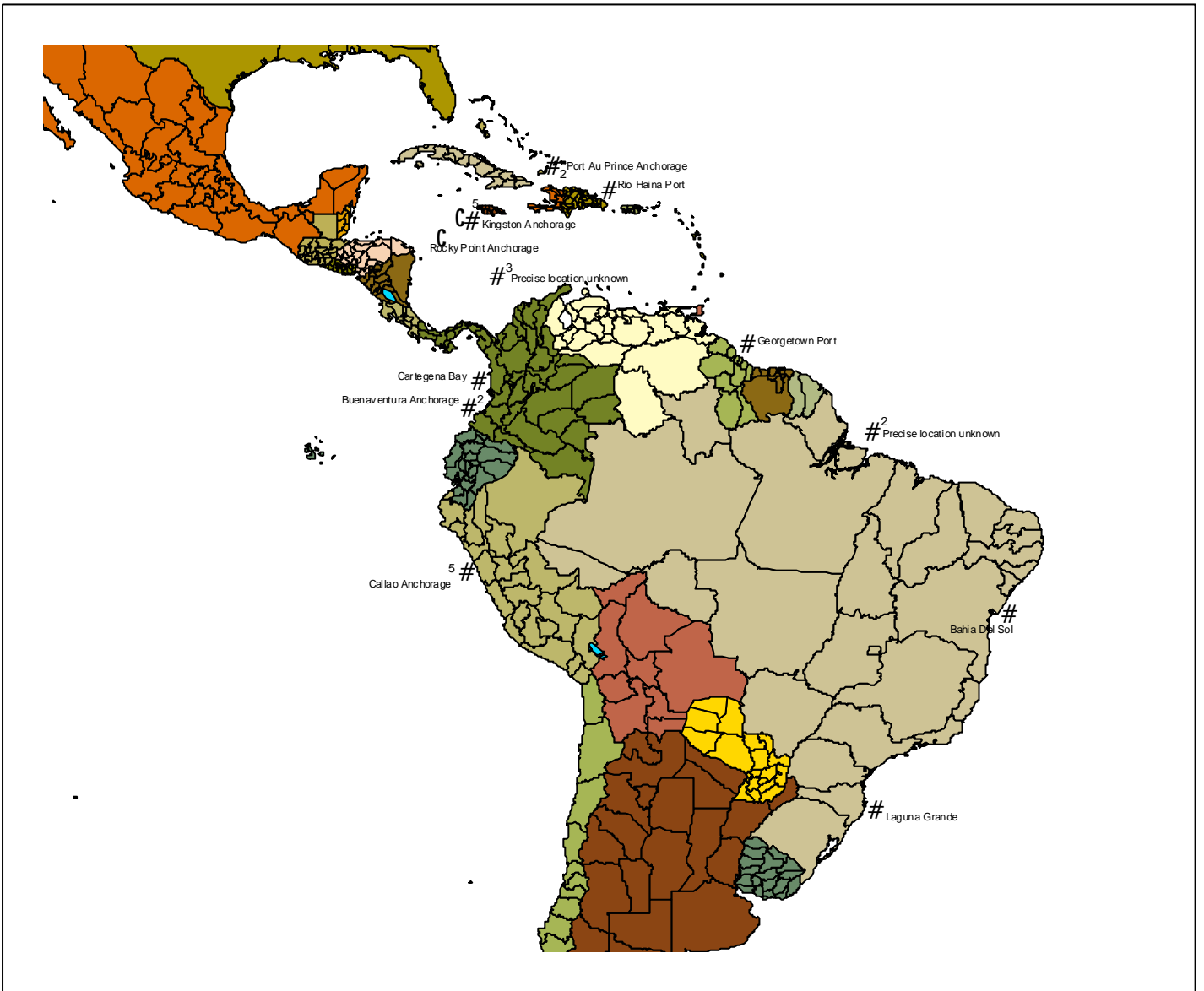
